Topic or theme

The topic planned for May is "People Who Help Us" we will be doing various activities to relate to this topic, such as learning all about how people in the community help us and visiting some of these venues. However the EYFS states that planning should follow your child's interests and individual needs therefore the topic will be changed if a child shows a particular interest. If your child has a particular interest please let us know and we will incorporate it into our planning.

Home Learning:

You can help your child's learning at home by spotting people who help us when out and about such as police officers, bus drivers etc. Continue practicing writing our own names and trying to forming the letters correctly. Counting object to ten and matching them with the correct numeral.

Half term

Pre-school will finish on Friday 24th May 2019 and will reopen again on Monday 3rd June 2019, if you require childcare for your child during half term please speak to Hilary or Kirsty on reception. Nursery will also be closed for a bank holiday on Monday 6th May 2019 and Monday 27th May 2019.

Sun cream and Sun Hats

Please could we ask that you send your child with a sun hat and sun cream now the weather has started to get warmer as we will be spending a lot of time outside, can we also ask that they are both labelled with their name and that cream is applied before coming to nursery.

Fancy Dress Day

On Friday 24th May 2019 we will be having a people who help us fancy dress day. Your child is welcome to come to pre-school dressed as their favourite occupation i.e. fireman, postman, police officer etc.

Appropriate Clothing

We will be going on lots of walks now the weather is starting to get nicer so could we ask that your child comes to pre-school in appropriate clothes for the weather on that day and suitable shoes for walking that are comfortable and do not fall off their feet.

Could we also ask that you label all of your child's clothing to avoid them getting lost or mixed up, there is also a drawstring bag on your child's peg for any spare clothes you wish to leave at nursery in case of any accidents.
